





Fluidmaster Recognizes World Plumbing Day with Volunteer Effort

The water saving toilets will replace each of the shelter's 30-year-old toilets, installed when Foothill was established in 1984.

"Given the significant water shortages in California, and the increasing maintenance requirements for these toilets as they enter their fourth decade of service, we're especially thankful for this highly useful donation by Fluidmaster, Vortens and Hirsch," said Kay Alexander, Board President of Foothill Family Shelter.

The donation will reduce overall water usage at the shelter, saving the organization in utility bills each month that may now in turn be used to assist families in the program. The toilets are in process of being installed with assistance from Fluidmaster employees.

"One of our Founder's Goals set forth in 1960 was to 'Be a Good Citizen in the Community.' World Plumbing Day allows us to contribute our own products and employee skills to a worthwhile cause, and it's a great opportunity to fully integrate our community involvement," said John Wohlfiel, Fluidmaster VP of Human Resources.
